


I'm so pleased we made it through this year with minimum disruption to our tennis club.

Our clubhouse has been given a fresh look thanks to Monash Council








Fabulous New Kitchen

A lot of close sets and great tennis played through the rain.

This year, we have over 100 kids playing junior competition for Glenburn. In the last season, there are 29 teams (13 Saturday and 16 Sunday), with 13 teams in the rubbers sections (A and B grade).

Our A1 boys team are moving up to senior competition next year after a lengthy tenure at the top of the table. A great sign for Glenburn that our senior teams now feature many past junior players.

Junior competition couldn't run without parents support that we've had. Many of our parents and team managers are helping out with running mornings at our alternate venues and Glenburn.

We've seen some great improvements with a lot more kids practicing and working together as a team. They have also shown very good behaviour and level of sportsmanship. We've had no behavioural issues which is quite amazing considering how many kids playing each week!

Pete Sampras is an American former world no 1 tennis player. Sampras won 14 major singles titles from 1988 to 2002 (an impressive record of 7 Wimbledon, 2 Australian Open, and 5 US Open titles). He was inducted to the International Tennis Hall of Fame in 2007.



Andre Agassi is also an American former world no 1 tennis player, a great rival of Pete Sampras with a contrasting playing style. Agassi is an eight-time major champion, an Olympic gold medallist, and also a runner-up in 7 other majors. He turned pro at the age of 16 and retired in 2006 with a career Golden Slam and Super Slam.

In the 1990s, Sampras was considered the greatest server and Agassi the greatest serve returner.









It was an all Glenburn affair in the D5 final with Glenburn Gold narrowly beating Glenburn Blue. Also, very well done to the B2 Boys winners.

Our coaching program has been very busy post-Covid. Some great results with a lot of our younger kids progressing from getting their first ball over the net to be able to rally ten shots in a row.

Our coaching themes range from swinglines, contact points, hip and shoulder rotation, footwork, stances, grips and tactical plays. The goal is to teach the fundamentals at a young age, so that as kids develop, their technique is sound, and they can develop powerful and consistent shots that will help them reaching their potential.

It's a great feeling as a coach, when you teach a student a technique and then see them beat you in a point with that technique!

Our encouragement to families is not to worry too much in the 'short term' about their kids grades and levels, but emphasize on their technique and skills. In the 'long term', that is the most important for their development.

Within our coaching team, coach Scott was a finalist for Vic coach of the year in the under 25 category.

Coaches Emma and Kevin have also completed their coaching courses.

As a new addition from our pennant team, we have coach Jackson that brought a great energy to the club.

All of our assistant coaches have worked hard with their ongoing development. All bring their unique skills and personality to the coaching program.

Our coaches all work as a 'team' and we all teach the same way when it comes to fundamental teaching.
